

Honorary Chairman/Team Manager - England Clubs and Schools U18

The England Clubs & Schools U18's programme is seeking to appoint an Honorary Chairman/Team Manager for the national squad. The post-holder will lead the England Clubs and Schools U18 Management & National Delivery Team, comprising the Assistant Team Manager, Coaching Staff, Chairman of Selectors, Medical Staff & Divisional U18 Chairmen to achieve the objectives of the RFU's Clubs and Schools U18 programme.

The position is for an 'overtime' volunteer and is unpaid, although travelling expenses will be reimbursed.

The England U18 Clubs & Schools XV provides national representative opportunity for gifted players who are not recruited to the RFU Elite Performance Pathway. Only players who participate in U18 CB and Divisional programmes are eligible for selection. The activity is overseen by the Community Age-Grade Representative Rugby Working Group reporting to Player Development Sub-Committee.

It is therefore vital that the Chairman/Team Manager be familiar with and committed to the RFU's policies in respect of schools and youth rugby as set down in the Player Pathway Report published in May 2010. The applicant should be generally respected as a person of authority within the game with a background in Constituent Body or preferably Divisional rugby. He or she will demonstrate the organisational and management skills commensurate with such a position, combined with tact and diplomacy.
