Scope

The Chair of Age Grade Rugby will champion the growth and development of Age Grade Rugby in the Somerset County RFU Member Clubs

Responsibilities

- Identifying the needs related to the Age Grade Game (Under 7s to Under 18s)
- Develop an action plan based on the identified needs
- Strive to grow the game by focusing on and delivering interventions that
- Increase the number of new Age Grade Rugby players in our Member Clubs
- Increase the retention rate of existing Age Grade Rugby players in our Member Clubs
- Increase the re-engagement of former Age Grade Rugby players in our Member Clubs
- Improving the quality of on-field and off-field workforce in our Member Clubs
- Prepare and manage the agreed budget for the areas of Age Grade Rugby Development identified in the Somerset County RFU Local Rugby Plan
- Prepare a report and attend meetings of the Somerset County RFU Management Committee and other appropriate meetings.
- Host forum meetings with Member Club Mini & Junior Chairs and / or Club Coaching Coordinators to create a joint understanding of the needs / solutions and action plans
- Chair the Somerset County RFU Age Grade Rugby sub-committee of volunteers to achieve these goals
- Work with the Somerset County RFU Management Committee and the RFU Local Delivery Team to accomplish the goals identified above
- Work in conjunction with the Somerset County RFU Safeguarding Manager to ensure adherence to the Rugby Football Union's Safeguarding Policy and the procedures, practices and guidelines and endorses and adopts the Policy Statement contained in that document and any successor policy.

Accountabilities:

The post holder is accountable to the Somerset County RFU's Management Committee for the successful delivery of the responsibilities as outlined above.

The post holder may delegate, as necessary, to the members of Age Grade Rugby sub-committee any task while retaining accountability and responsibility.
